Following are a few of our favorite restaurants in La Paz. Most we have personally tried and can recommend. This list is by no means complete, and restaurants come and go, so it's always best to check with the restaurant to confirm their hours and location.

Fine Dining

- <u>Sorstis</u> (corner of Revolucion de 1910 and Constitucion). Italian, steaks, seafood, large menu, great wine list, beautiful outside patio.
- Nim (corner of Revolucion de 1910 and Miguel Hidalgo). Mediterranian fusion cuisine. Wonderful appetizers, great mole, fresh fish.
- Las Tres Virgenes (Calle Madero near Miguel Hidalgo). Steak and seafood, very nice court-yard patio, good vibe.
- <u>Palermo's</u> steakhouse (on the Malecon just after Miguel Hidalgo).
- <u>Cava Sur</u> restaurant and wine bar (Ignacio Allende near Primo Verdad). Great food, nice
 - wines by the glass or bottle, and live music most weekends.
- Azul Marino (inside Costa Baja marina). Good selection of seafood, steaks, pasta, pizza. Sister restaurant to Nim.
- <u>Tatanka</u> (on Revolution between Nicholas Bravo and Melchor Ocampo). Seafood and steaks, lovely interior patio or indoor seating.

- <u>Buffalo</u> (inside Hotel La Posada). Excellent seared pulpo (octopus), good steaks, tacos and burgers.
- <u>Steinbecks</u> (at Costa Baja resort). Resort dining with excellent food, nice atmosphere.
- Mariscos Bismarkcito (on the malecon near Miguel Hidalgo). Wide range of seafood including lobster, great view of the bay.
- <u>La Costa</u> (Antonio Navarro and Rangel). Reasonably priced seafood, next to the marina.
- <u>Sitges</u> (5 de Mayo just behind the malecon). Great tapas (small plates), entrees and wines by the glass. Nice little courtyard.



Traditional Mexican

- Los Magueyes (corner of Allende and Guillermo Prieta). Authentic Mexican restaurant, try the fajitas made with steak, chicken, chorizo, bacon, peppers, onions and cheese, and the flaming tableside dessert coffees.
- Maria California (Bellisario Dominguez and Benito Huarez). Excellent breakfast or brunch, huge menu, wide variety of fresh juices and nice outdoor patio.
- <u>El Zarape</u> (on malecon near Guadalupe Victoria). Authentic Mexican food at reasonable prices and a view of the bay.
- El Molinito (on the malecon near Campeche).
 Seafood and authentic Mexican cuisine.
- <u>La Marmolera</u> (Cuauhtemoc near Aquiles Serdan). Breakfast and lunch, very casual.

Burgers, Ribs, Pizza, Sandwiches, Salads

• Harker Boards (on the malecon just past Cinco de Mayo). Same place that rents SUPs. Restaurant is upstairs. Burgers and fresh-cut French fries, pizzas and salads, wraps, and Baja Brewing on tap. Best sunset view from the top deck.

- <u>El Mezquite Grill</u>. Excellent steaks, burgers and seared tuna. Casual local place, good prices.
- <u>Fuego y Lena</u> (on Ignacio Allende near Calle Madero). Huge menu, authentic Italian pizza, burgers, salads and pasta. Nice patio setting, good prices.
- Il Rustico (Revolucion de 1910 near Nicolas Bravo). Voted one of the best pizzas in town, good pasta and other Italian dishes.
- <u>Buffalito Grill</u> (Bellisario Dominquez and Constitucion). Burgers and steaks, good prices.
- <u>Bandido's Grill</u> (Topete and Antonio Navarro). Burgers, fries and onion rings, outdoor patio.
- <u>J&R Ribs</u> (corner of Bellisario Dominguez and 5 de Mayo). Small place that serves some of the best ribs in town!
- <u>Dulce Romero</u> (Ignacio Allende near Madero). Excellent salads, sandwiches and breakfast, take home fresh baked bread from the bakery.
- <u>City Salads</u> (in Plaza Nautica on Abbasolo near Colima). Huge salads made on the spot, a small order can easily feed two people.



Tacos

- Claro's Fish Jr. Try the "crunchy" fish or shrimp tacos, large topping bar with lots of options. (1 block off the malecon, behind the Applebees).
- <u>Rancho Viejo</u> (on the malecon and larger location at the corner of Manuel Marquez de Leon and Bellesario Domingo). The best arrachera steak tacos, you can also get it to go by the kilo.
- Mariscos El Toro Guero (Mariano Abasolo and Calle Sinaloa). Look for the big yellow building with the palapa roof. Very good fried fish or shrimp tacos, 1 order is enough to feed two with extra tortillas, or take home the leftovers.
- <u>Tacofish La Paz</u> (Marquez de Leon near Heroes de Independencia). Great fish and shrimp tacos, great salsa bar, and low prices.
- <u>Taqueria El Paisa</u> (Abasolo and Antonio Navarro). Get the tortas (like a tostada) or the tacos el pastor (barbequed pork). Only open for dinner. Bring your own beer.

Sushi

- Odayaka (inside the Costa Baja marina). Very large menu with excellent fresh sushi, perhaps the best in town.
- <u>Jiro Sushi</u> (the one on Abasolo near Colima). This location seems to have the best quality and consistency, but the one on the malecon (next to the Breeze Mart) has the best view.
- <u>Mahi</u> (on the Malecon near the big pier). High quality sushi, view of the bay, and tasty cucumber margaritas. Plus, it's right next to the ice cream shop.

Coffee Shops

- <u>Doce Cuarenta</u> (Calle Madero near 5 de Mayo). Modern, hip coffee shop with courtyard patio, next to the farmer's market. Good breakfast and lunch options. Browse the Got Baja store for souvenirs and free tourist maps.
- Starbucks (in the Shoppes at La Paz, behind Liverpool). Just in case you can't do without it!
